

### Mississippi Veterinary License Application Procedure:

1. Complete application
2. Submit NBE and CCT grades or NAVLE score from AAVSB
3. Copy of diploma or official transcript from veterinary college/school
4. The Regular Fee of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)
5. Letters of good standing from every jurisdiction in which applicant has ever held a license to practice veterinary medicine
6. Passport quality and size photograph (taken within the past 6 months)
7. Three (3) letters of recommendation from licensed veterinarians.

The application may be completed in paper form or through the online licensure portal.

Once the application is completed applicants will be sent a link to take the state board exam through AAVSB's SPA program. There is an additional \$50.00 charge that applicants will pay directly to AAVSB.

When the applicant has completed the application process and passed the state board exam their license will be issued.

Licenses will expire on July 31 of the year following initial licensure.

Any applicant who does not pass the state board exam must wait 60 days to retake the exam and will have to pay the \$50.00 testing fee to AAVSB for each attempt.
