

To file a complaint:

1. Outline the facts of the complaint in the space provided on the front of this form.
2. Sign the complaint and have your signature notarized.
3. If additional pages are needed to state your complaint, be sure to sign these extra sheets.
4. Attach to the complaint photo static copies of documents or letters directly related to the facts of the complaint.
5. Mail the complaint and attachments to:

6. You do not have to use this form. You may submit your complaint in a letter or affidavit as long as your signature is notarized.

Complaints Procedure:

Your complaint will be screened by the Mississippi Board of Veterinary Medicine as to its merit. If found meritorious, the attorney retained by the Board of Veterinary Medicine will investigate and bring disciplinary charges against a veterinarian (or non-veterinarian) when the Board feels that such charges are warranted. All complaints and information gained through investigations are privileged and confidential, and are the property of the Mississippi Board of Veterinary Medicine.
